Summer Tuition and Fees:

Cost per unit: \$470

Add/Drop fee: \$35

Summer Registration dates: April 6 - 30

Payment in full for summer term is due May 7, 2010 or students will be dropped from class.

If dropped from class, you may re-register during late registration, see details below.

Late Registration dates: May 3 - 28

Payment in full for summer term is due at the time of late registration. Students may only register for classes which begin June 1 or June 15.

Dropping a class and refund schedule:

Prior to class starting: removed from transcript and 100% refund

Within the first week (7 calendar days) of class: "W" on transcript and 80% refund

Within the second week (8-14 calendar days) of class: "W" on transcript and 40% refund *

Within the third week (15-21 calendar days) of class: "W" on transcript and 0% refund

Withdrawals are not accepted after the third week of class.

Financial Aid:

In rare cases, federal aid may be available for summer classes. You must have completed the 2009-2010 FAFSA to be eligible. Please see the Financial Aid department with questions.
