In planning your program, remember that William Jessup University can accept no more than 70 lower division units or ½ your total number of units for this major. Those courses numbered 300-400 at William Jessup University are best taken at William Jessup since they are upper division classes.

Students completing four years of the same second language during high school will be allowed six units of humanities electives to meet the second language requirement.

Courses within the Liberal Studies major for which no transfer credit will be accepted include: Teaching as a Profession, upper division curriculum & methods courses, and student teaching courses.
