Additional Notes on Cost

Primary Health Insurance Coverage:

WJU, like many other universities throughout California, follows a hard waiver policy. Insurance coverage has always been a mandatory part of registration for students who carry more than six units. Students found in non-compliance may result in disciplinary action up to and including dismissal.

In order to waive out of the WJU student medical insurance program **you must** submit a completed waiver form along with proof of existing insurance coverage.

Proof of health insurance coverage consists of:

- ≈ Copy (front and back) of current insurance card
- ≈ Copy of current policy
- ≈ Or a letter from the insurance company stating effective coverage dates.

Your proof of existing health insurance coverage must be submitted to the Student Life office by August 31, 2008 for new students, otherwise you will be enrolled in WJU's student medical insurance plan and charged accordingly. This charge is non-refundable. If a student drops below six units per semester after the initial registration for classes, his/her insurance coverage will remain in force for that semester. If a student drops out of school after the first week of school, he/she will not qualify for an insurance refund, but the insurance will remain in effect for the completion of that semester. Athletic Insurance Fee: (\$400 fee)

The Athletic Participation Fee charged to all students eligible to participate in the University's Intercollegiate Athletic Programs includes a secondary insurance which will not be waived with proof of other insurance. Students can choose to pay the full amount of this fee prior to registration, at registration, or in three equal payments if the athlete is in the first term of participation. Deferred payments will be due according to the University's Deferred Payment Program (see published schedule).
