You may either pay the entire amount or make three installments (adding a \$40 deferred payment fee to your first payment for each semester).

A processing fee will apply. You may also pay in the Business Office with cash or check. **This worksheet is provided as an estimate only.**

Additional Notes on Cost

Primary Health Insurance Coverage:

Insurance coverage is mandatory for students who carry more than six units each term. All students are automatically enrolled in the WJU medical insurance plan. To opt out of WJU insurance (if a student is covered under a parents' policy or has personal insurance), proof of current insurance and a waiver form must be submitted to the Student Life office. The waiver form can be found on the Student Life section of the WJU website.

If you drop below six units per semester after the initial registration for classes, insurance coverage will remain in place for that semester. If you drop out of school after the first week of school, you will not qualify for a refund, but the insurance will remain in effect for the completion of that semester.
