Who is eligible: This grant is competitive and based on financial need, academic achievement, and demonstrated leadership and vision through multiculturalism. To be eligible to apply, a student must meet the minimum requirements for an academic scholarship. Amount: The amount of the grant is up to \$4,000 (dispersed evenly per semester) and is renewable each year if the student maintains a WJU GPA of 3.0.

Requirements: Essay response (see below) and must have submitted the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If selected, the recipient must live on campus and be active with multicultural educational activities on campus.
