# WILLIAM JESSUP UNIVERSITY HOMESCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The WJU Homeschool Scholarship is offered to one first time, first-year student on the basis of academic achievement, a response to the essay question below and a formal interview during a special on-campus event.

Applicants must have completed all four years of high school through a homeschool program and meet the following minimum eligibility requirements to be considered for this award:

- Academic GPA (weighted or unweighted): 3.25

**AND**

- SAT (Critical Reading and Math): 1000 **OR** ACT (Composite): 21

The scholarship amount is \$5,000 annually (\$2,500/semester) and is renewable annually if the recipient:

- Maintains a WJU GPA of 3.00 or above.
- Maintains full-time status.
- Does not step out for more than one approved semester leave of absence.
- Lives on campus for at least the first two years.
  - Subsequently, according to the Student Life residence living requirements as outlined in the catalog.

***Essay Question: On a separate sheet of paper, please respond to the following:***

Arguably, a homeschool education provides a more sound foundation for college preparation. Taking into consideration your own spiritual development, academic instruction and community involvement during your homeschooled years, do you agree? Please elaborate.

**Deadline:** Postmarked by February 1; submit this form and the essay response. The WJU Homeschool Scholarship applicant must also have completed the process of applying for admission by February 1. The recipient of the WJU Homeschool Scholarship will be notified by March 15.
