ADMISSION PHILOSOPHY

As you may recall, the WJU vision is that our graduates will be transformed and will help redeem world culture by providing notable servant leadership; by enriching family, church and community life; and by serving with distinction in their chosen career. WJU seeks to select those students with a desire to return to our campus, who while at WJU, demonstrated strong academic ambition and promising potential, diverse interests, and a desire to support the values of the University.

The reapplicant may apply for either the fall or spring semester. Criteria important to WJU in considering the reapplicant are:

1. You left WJU in good academic standing
2. You can be cleared through Student Life and,
3. Your student account was paid in full.

Should there be a question on any of these three criteria, we suggest you call the Registrar's Office, Student Life Office or the Business Office, respectively. If you left WJU due to either an academic or student life suspension, contact the respective office to reconcile any reinstatement requirements. The Admission Office will also be communicating with these offices on your behalf.

HOW TO APPLY

(For Reapplicants)

The Traditional Undergraduate Admission Office begins receiving applications on September 1 for the following fall semester and September 1 for spring. The APPLICATION FOR READMISSION and all supporting documents, must be received for Fall admission, by April 1 (postmarked) and for Spring admission, by December 15 (postmarked). Should the reapplication be submitted after these deadlines, the reapplicant will be considered on a space available basis only. Should an offer of admission be made and the reapplicant confirms after the deadline stated in the acceptance letter, the reapplicant's confirmation will be accepted on a space available basis only. Please follow these steps:

1. Complete and return the APPLICATION FOR READMISSION, along with a \$35 non-refundable application fee (payable to William Jessup University). *See priority deadline dates above.*
2. Request that an official transcript from each school you've attended since leaving WJU (whether credit was completed or not) be sent to the Traditional Undergraduate Admission Office.
3. If any college work is in progress at the time of this application, be sure an additional final transcript is sent when the work is complete.
