School of Professional Studies Transfer Course Recommendations

William Jessup University follows the IGETC CSU transfer curriculum. The CSU requirement in U.S. History, Constitution, and American Ideals is met by completing two courses from Area 4F in either Humanities or Social Sciences.

Program specific course requirements can be found in the chart below, indicating the area each specific course will cover.

WJU Program	IGETC Area	Gen. Ed. Course	Units	Transfer Requirement
Business Administration	4B	Microeconomics	3	Must focus on choices of individual/household economics.
Organizational Leadership	4B	Microeconomics	3	Must focus on choices of individual/household economics.
Psychology	4I	Intro to Psychology	3	Introduction of the study of human behavior and mental processes.
	4G/I	Developmental Psychology	3	Must cover lifespan from prenatal to old age.

All courses must meet the following standards to be eligible for transfer:

- Grade “C” (2.0) or better
- Maximum of 70 semester transferrable units from accredited community colleges.
- Maximum of 4 units in Physical Education will transfer.
- Maximum of 8 units in applied coursework, including choir, drawing, and other “hands-on” courses.
- Occupational/vocational coursework is not eligible for transfer.

CSU (or IGETC) certification automatically fulfills William Jessup University’s General Education (lower division) requirements.
